**GOSPEL REFLECTION**

**Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21**

Just as Ezra, in our first reading, read to the people from Scripture, Jesus reads from the book of the prophet Isaiah about the Servant of the Lord. He announces that He is the fulfillment of Scripture. Then He tells the crowd in the synagogue that He is the one sent by God. His presence is their guarantee that a “year of favor,” or time of salvation, has begun. All eyes are glued on Him as he puts down the scroll and takes His seat.

*Discussion Questions: In this Gospel, Jesus identifies Himself as the Messiah, as the one Isaiah foretold would come to the people. He did this at the weekly worship at His local synagogue. The Gospel tells us that He was in the habit of worshipping there weekly. Why did Jesus worship weekly? What does this habit of Jesus’ tell us about the importance of our weekly worship? Where do we meet Jesus, the Messiah, on a weekly basis?*
