

GOD WITH US

God's treatment for insignificance won't lead you to a bar or dating service, a spouse or social club. God's ultimate cure for the common life takes you to a manger. The babe of Bethlehem. Emmanuel. Remember the promise of the angel? "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call Him Emmanuel which translated "God is with us" (Matt. 1:23)

The name appears in the same Hebrew form as it did two thousand years ago. Emmanu means "with us". "El" refers to Elohim, or God. Not an "above us God" or a "somewhere in the neighborhood God." He came as the "with us God." God is with us.

Not "God with the rich" or "God with the religious." But God with *us.* All of us. Russians, Germans, Buddhists, Mormons, truckdrivers and taxi drivers, librarians. God with *us.*

GOSPEL REFLECTION Matthew 2:1-12

The story of the astrologers, or magi, following the light of a distant star is full of surprises. The astrologers, who were Gentiles, were the first to worship Jesus as the newborn King of the Jews. They found him, not in a palace surrounded by signs of wealth and might, but as a helpless baby in the arms of Mary, His mother. Yet the astrologers believed and worshiped Him, offering Him gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. Then, Matthew tells us, full of joy and wonder, they returned to their distant homes. The astrologers had the faith and wisdom to see in this baby the promised Messiah. Christ shows Himself to us, too, and comes into our lives in many ways and through many people. If we are people of faith, we will find Him in these little "epiphanies". We will offer Him our own giftsour prayers and worship, our loving service of others, and our constant faith, even when it might seem hard to find Him.

Discussion Question: Reflect on some of the "little epiphanies" in your life. Share that with others.
