**IS IT LOVING?***Love is not rude*

1Corinthians 13:5 NIV

When defining what love is not, Paul put *rudeness* on the list. "It is not rude." The Greek word for *rude* means shameful or disgraceful behavior.

An example of rudeness was recently taken before the courts in Minnesota. A man fell out of his canoe and lost his temper. Though the river was lined with vacationing families, he polluted the air with obscenities. Some of those families sued him. He said, "I have my rights."

God calls us to a higher, more noble concern. Not "What are my rights?" but "What is loving?"

Do you have the right to dominate a conversation? Yes, but is it loving to do so?...

Is it within your rights to bark at the clerk or snap at the kids? Yes. But is it loving to act this way?

GOSPEL REFLECTION

John 1:35-42

Today's Gospel tells us about the call of the first disciples. Followers of John the Baptist responded to the gentle invitation of Jesus; they came and stayed the whole day with Him. Then these disciples called their friends to join them. One of them was Simon, Jesus told him that he would be called Peter, or Cephas, a Greek word for "rock". One day the Church would be built on the rocklike faith of Peter.

Discussion Questions: When Jesus enters our lives with the gentle call of His grace, how will we reply? Will we be busy with other things, afraid He will ask too much of us? Or will we trust him? Will we be open to His call and a new beginning in our lives?
