THE NEW HOSPICE RESIDENTIAL HOME
LEAMINGTON, ONTARIO

The new Hospice Residential Home in Leamington opened in April. It is located behind Arby's on Talbot St. W. It is a 10 bed facility providing 24 hour care for people with life-altering diagnosis. Each suite has natural light, its own sitting area, granite fireplace and private bathroom/shower, small kitchenette with fridge. Trained Hospice volunteers play a very important role by providing care for residents. They assist with patient care, reception, food preparation, house-keeping, garden and maintenance. Palliative care physicians make rounds and provide on-call service. Other services such as spiritual care, social work, Therapeutic Touch, massage therapy and pet therapy are also offered and compliment the traditional medical care given. The Home is for individuals and families whose diagnosis and care needs have progressed to a point beyond which their care can no longer be managed at home. *For more info. call 519-974-7100.*

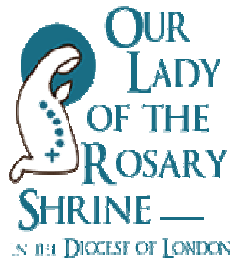
READINGS-July 17, 2016

ASSURANCE OF SALVATION II

When someone becomes a Christian, is their ticket to heaven automatically punched, period, end of story? Or does that ticket come with any stipulations? Let's look at the Biblical evidence. In Matthew 7:21 Jesus says, "*Not everyone who says to me "Lord, Lord" will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven.*" St. Paul warns against over-confidence in 1 Corinthians 10:12, "whoever thinks he is standing secure should take care not to fall." And in 1 Cor. 9:27 St. Paul talks about himself saying "for fear that, after having preached to others, I myself should be disqualified." Certainly not the words of a man who knows that his ticket is punched.

The Catholic Church has always taught that salvation requires perseverance in faith. The Catechism says..."nor will anyone obtain eternal life but he who endures to the end." Her teachings echo the words of St. Paul to Timothy in 2 Timothy 2:12, "if we persevere, we shall also reign with Him. But if we deny Him. He will deny us."
