VOCATIONS INFORMATION

"This Month is a focus on Permanent Deacons"

The Permanent Diaconate is essentially a ministry of service and charity. The Deacon serves the church and the diocese in a designated area of service such as hospital, hospice or other forms of charitable outreach. The Deacon is assigned to a parish as his liturgical base, where he assists the Pastor as needed in liturgical ministry, assisting at Mass, preaching, baptizing, presiding at weddings or funerals or in other capacities within the parish. Deacons may be married and their spouse is involved in the vocation and ministry of their Deacon Husband. Deacon formation lasts four years (studying at St. Peter's Seminary in London). Deacons in Canada are not paid for their ministry—it is strictly voluntary. They share in the Sacrament of Holy Orders with Bishops and Priests.

CATHOLIC APOLOGETICS (The Bible)

Where does the Bible come from? That might sound like a strange question. The Catholic Church has always taught that the Bible is the inspired, inerrant Word of God. But remember, in the years immediately following the Resurrection of our Lord, there was no New Testament...only the Church. In the first few centuries of Christianity, there were literally hundreds of letters and books circulating among churches. So how do we know that the 27 books in the New Testament are divinely inspired and supposed to be in the Bible? Late in the 4th Century A.D., Catholic bishops met in council at both Carthage and Hippo, and with the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, decided on what books belonged in the New Testament. It is the Holy Catholic Church that was given the authority by Christ to determine the canon of Scripture. St. Augustine said, "I would not believe in the Gospels were it not for the authority of the Catholic Church." You see, the Bible didn't just fall out of the sky, or off a local printing press. There had to be an authoritative Church before the New Testament was ever written to determine what books would be in the New Testament. *If you accept the authority of the New Testament, then you accept the authority of the Catholic Church.*

Dear fellow parishioners,

On behalf of the Syrian Refugee Sponsorship Committee I'd like to give an update on the process as there may be some questions as to where our sponsored families are.

When we began fundraising to sponsor a family we had not yet selected a family since we needed to see how much money we would be able to raise before deciding how many people we could commit to sponsoring. As you may recall the newly elected Liberal government had set the goal to relocate 25,000 Syrian refugees by February of this year and they added resources and manpower to expedite that process. There were hundreds of Syrians arriving daily at airports in Canada from December 2015 to February 2016, until the 25,000 person goal had been reached. At that point the expedited process was terminated and many sponsorship groups such as ours who had raised significant funds were left waiting for paperwork and processing to be completed at the normal snail's pace. Fortunately, due to complaints and pressure from sponsorship groups (including ours) Citizenship and Immigration Canada extended the expedited processing time until the end of March 2016 which allowed us to get the paperwork in for our first family. I was told that the waiting time for expedited processing would be any where between 2 to 9 months. I receive very few updates and little information about where the family is and how much longer before they will arrive despite asking for that information. I have been informed that our first family has passed all of their screening exams and their physical exams which means they are cleared for travel to Canada. That means that they could be coming at any time, however I do not have a date, and won't be notified until likely days before they arrive.

The paperwork for our second family did not get in before the expedited processing window had closed. As a result, in all likelihood our second sponsored family will not be arriving until sometime in 2017. The times to process refugees are dependant on the resources and manpower that Citizenship and Immigration Canada and the United Nations dedicate to doing so. All of this is completely out of our hands.

Many within our community have generously donated to our sponsorship fund and I would like to be clear that the funds which were raised are fully intact and have not been spent on anything. We continue to take donations of items which the families will need once they arrive. We are also working to find suitable housing for the families which is a challenge in our area.

I understand that there may be some frustration and concern at the length of time it is taking for all of this to materialize. Please remember that we are dealing with a situation which involves security and public health in doing all of the proper screening and medical checks, not to mention the bureaucracy. For those who are concerned or frustrated about the delay please consider how frustrating it must be for the families to be subject to all of the physical and background checks and then having to just wait as homeless foreigners until it is their turn to board a plane to Canada.
