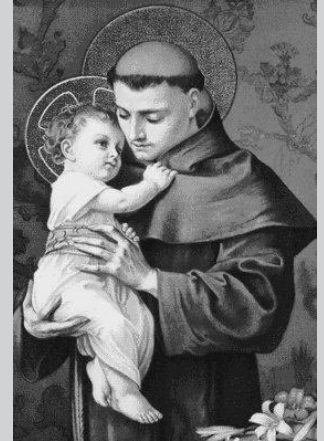

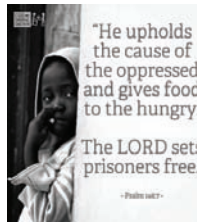

Over the past month (in between the rain falls) the weeds have been sprayed and pulled; sprayed and pulled... on numerous occasions, to the point that we were able to distinguish between flowers and weeds. Trees and bushes were trimmed and pruned and some had to be removed due to the harsh winter. Now that the biggest task has been completed, it needs to be kept up. Therefore, I am requesting again those who could volunteer an occasional few hours to work with a group of others to stay ahead of the task. These 5 hands made the work light, so just imagine what it would be like to have a "league of garden angels!" Also, a special thanks to Murray Wilson and Ted Gorski who volunteered their time in spraying the weeds. As we are a clustered parish we certainly encourage the involvement of our St. John's parishioners as well. Perhaps more will volunteer the next time around.

Why not take a stroll around and through the gardens and admire the beauty of the property.

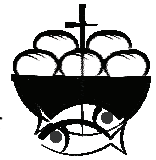

FEEDING THE WORLD

With today's two accounts of feeding miracles and the psalm response about the Lord's hand feeding us, it is easy to gloss over the marvelous hymn in Ephesians. It is built around the most potent biblical numbers: one, three, and seven. The core of it is the word "one" expressed seven times. Three of these describe the church: one body, one Spirit, one hope; the next three are the foundations of the church: one Lord [Jesus], one faith, one baptism. All of these are bound up together in the one Father of all. While we might feel daunted by the prospect of duplicating the wonders worked by Elisha and Jesus in the feeding of multitudes, Ephesians gives us a more realistic way to live and "feed" others as the church: by living in humility and gentleness, by acting with patience, bearing with each other in love, and always seeking and striving to preserve unity through peace. Who among us cannot increase the way we "feed" the church and the world by living this way? We are always called upon to "feed" the world in the literal sense; but our mission as church tells us that others are also fed by the way we live and act each moment of each day.
