

GOSPEL REFLECTION Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

When people arrive at their parish church to celebrate Mass, they are often distracted by many things. But this Gospel reminds us of what Eucharist is all about. It helps us to focus on the Last Supper, the final Passover meal Jesus shared with His friends. There we hear Him say those familiar and astounding words: "This is my body, this is my blood." The breaking of the bread and pouring out of the wine reminds us once again of how Jesus' body was broken on the cross and how His blood was spilled for us. Now we are His body on earth. And we are nourished by His Eucharistic presence among us.

Discussion Questions: Who or what helps you to get "lugged into" what is really happening in the celebration of the Eucharist. How would you describe the difference the Eucharist makes in your life: What can you do to help others appreciate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ?
