

#### GOSPEL REFLECTION John 3:16-18

In today's Gospel, Jesus is speaking to a Pharisee named Nicodemus. Nicodemus has come to consult Jesus because he recognizes that Jesus is a great teacher sent by God. However, Nicodemus has not yet recognized that Jesus is the Son of God, who has come to save all who believe in Him. Those who hear Jesus and accept His word will have eternal life.

Discussion Questions: Each of us is unique—as the song says, "There will Never be Another You". Fill in your own name in each of the blank spaces: God so loved\_\_\_\_\_ that he gave his only Son, that\_\_\_\_\_, who believes in Him, may have eternal life. God did not send the Son to\_\_\_\_\_\_ to condemn him/her, but that\_\_\_\_\_might be saved through Him. What is your response to this message? How can you share it with others?
