THIRD ADDITION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL

On November 27, 2011, the First Sunday of Advent, we will be implementing the Third Edition of the Roman Missal. Over the next months we will be offering information about the changes called for by this third edition. However, this is an ideal time to learn more about the meaning of the Mass, the Eucharist, and to reflect on the meaning of our actions, song and prayer. This is the time to learn why silence is beneficial; what it means to be united at the table of the Word and the table of the Eucharist how Christ becomes present to us in Word, Sacrament, assembly and presbyter; how Jesus sends us into the world.

To help us make a good transition, **each Sunday from July 3rd to November 13th a bulletin insert will be provided with a reflection question or action.** Every parishioner will receive the same information on the same weekend, so that we may grow together through the changes.

We encourage families and/or groups of friends to enjoy some conversation about the bulletin information. Together as a Diocese we will become more attuned to the great gift we celebrate, the Eucharist.

GOSPEL REFLECTION-June 26

John 6:51-58

Today's reading takes place the day after Jesus has miraculously fed five thousand people with only five loaves and two fish. Now He wants the crowds to understand that He has come to give them "the living bread." Earthly bread, even manna, can only keep us alive for a time but it cannot give us eternal life. Only Jesus Himself, the Bread of Life, can do that. As Catholics, our greatest prayer of thanks is the Mass. Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist. When we receive Communion, we say Amen; that is, we believe that the bread and wine are now the Body and Blood of Christ.

Discussion Questions: One of the dictionary definitions of eternity is "without intermission". What moments of your life need healing? What moments of your life would you like to bring into eternity?

GOSPEL REFLECTION-July 3

Matthew 11:25-30

At the beginning of today's Gospel, we hear Jesus' hymn of praise to the Father. He is closer to the Father than anyone has ever been or ever will be. In fact, He is one with the Father. Jesus is both God and man. Jesus assures us that He is "gentle and humble of heart." This gentleness is not weakness, but the strength to accept us as we are, as well as the strength to help and save us. Jesus tells us that we are to be like Him in this gentleness and humility. This does not mean being a pushover. It means being patient with and respectful to others, being a peacemaker, as Jesus was. It means accepting others as they are and trying to help them become even better.

Discussion Questions: What do we mean when we say someone is "down to earth"? That is what humility is! It is the opposite of snobby and a great compliment. How will you be humble today and gentle to yourself and others?
