**Prayer and Worship**

Our family of faith is one that recognizes the importance of prayer in all that we do. Prayer is the common bond that we share as a family, regardless of our language, age or geographic location. From the child praying before bed to the prayer group at the parish, our family of faith continues to pray for those in our community and those around the world.

Everyone is called to live a "vital and personal relationship with the living and true God. This relationship is prayer." *Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2558*

We can pray alone or with others; we worship together as parish communities at Mass and pray as families. There are many types of prayer and many different styles of worship, but all center on living and experiencing our relationship with the living God.

**Four basic elements...**

- Blessing and Adoration (praising God)
- Prayer of Petition (asking for what we need, including forgiveness)
- Prayer of Intercession (asking for what others need)
- Prayer of Thanksgiving (for what God has given and done)

**Tips for praying:**

- Find a quiet place and time
- Calm yourself and put away distractions
- Speak what you feel to God, or use set prayers
- Take time to listen
- Use the Bible in your prayer
- Consider keeping a prayer journal

From Fr Tom...



Parishes are called to be “**missionary**”. Bishop Fabbro has challenged us to, “being a mission oriented church that forms disciples of Jesus.” This mission of evangelization, of proclaiming and living the gospel message, belongs to every baptized member of the Church.

A missionary parish reaches out to those who do not know Christ by welcoming them and sharing the Good News with them.

A missionary parish is also one that educates and forms its members in the faith so that they can live their discipleship completely.

A missionary parish continues to spiritually strengthen parishioners to live their faith boldly and to

share it through witness and outreach to others.

#### **WHEN?**

As you may remember, we hope to soon activate our new Family of Parishes. The churches in Leamington/Wheatley, Kingsville and Pelee Island will be one “Family of Parishes”, with one pastor and one pastoral team.

We anticipate this activation will take place in July. We wait for the official announcement from Bishop Fabbro.

In our last update, I spoke to you about our “transition team”. We had begun to meet regularly to prepare for our activation and will begin to meet again once ministries in the Churches resume.

However, we have been working behind the scenes and have been able to make some decisions already...

#### **NAME**

Our parishes will keep their own their own name, and while some of the expenses will be shared (e.g. priest salaries), each parish will be responsible for its own finances. The region which includes all these churches will be called:

**“Erie Shores South Catholic Family of Parishes”**

Fr Tom will be the pastor of Erie Shores South Catholic Family of Parishes, and Fr Steve will continue to serve as the parochial vicar. We will continue to be assisted by Fr Kazimierz to serve the migrant worker community.

**MINISTRIES**

Many of the ministries, activities and sacramental preparation will be shared, while others will continue to be independent. For example, there would be one RCIA program, and one pastoral council with members from all places. However, groups like the CWL and Knights of Columbus (though they might work together more often) will still have their own independent meetings.

**LOGO**

I have chosen as a motto for our family: **UNITAS IN CHRISTO** (“Unity in Christ”). Each person, and each parish with its own unique character, and each nationality with their own traditions are united by one thing – their faith in Jesus as Lord and Savior.

*The image is of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, with the rays of blood and water which symbolize the birth of the Church. The rays flow into the water which symbolizes Lake Erie which is the geographic location that unites all our communities.*

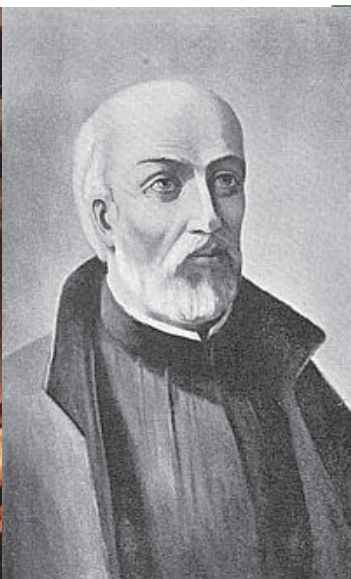

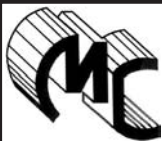

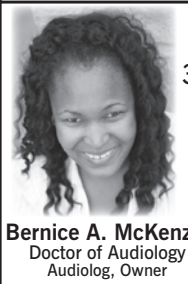
