Prayer Wall it is a centuries old tradition to place a note with a prayer request in the Western Wall in Jerusalem. Every day people bring their prayers, write them on bits of paper and put them in the cracks in the wall. This year, during Lent we will have a Prayer Wall in each church, similar to the wailing wall in the sense we can write any kind of prayer we would like to offer on the pieces of coloured paper provided and then roll them up and put them in the holes. What kinds of things can we offer prayers for? We can pray for someone, (healing, help), pray for ourselves (courage, strength, to deal with a particular situation), thanksgiving, for a particular situation – asking successful outcome. We can pray for anything! One of the great opportunities with a prayer wall, is we can share each other's prayers by taking one of the rolled up papers with our prayer intention on it. You can write a prayer and/or you can take a prayer.
