

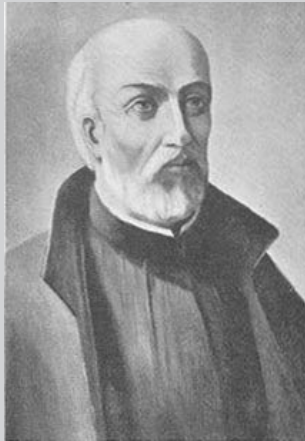

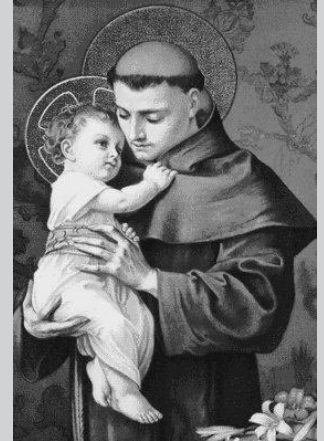

**UPDATE ON EXPENSES OF ST. ANTHONY  
HALL DEMOLITION**

We recently received the final tally of expenses for the demolition of the hall at St. Anthony’s, Harrow. The grand total came to: **\$66,006.98**

A total of \$12,495.00 was donated from September 11<sup>th</sup> to December 24, 2017 from the parishioners, leaving a bill totaling: **\$ 53,511.98**. After paying all these expenses from our savings, it leaves us with **\$85,423.53** held in our Diocesan Deposit Fund (Savings Account)
