GOSPEL REFLECTION**Matthew 4:1-11**

As Jesus prepares to begin His ministry, He enters a kind of spiritual "training camp." Alone in the desert, He fasts and prays for forty days. When the devil tries to ambush Him with three temptations to disobey God's will, Jesus is well armed. He defends Himself with the word of God by quoting from the Book of Deuteronomy. He refuses to be tricked by false promises of power and glory.

Discussion Questions: *Lent can be a spiritual training camp for us today. It is a time to practice using God's word as our defensive weapon against temptation. What spiritual training plans will you put into practice during Lent? Prayer and fasting are traditional. Today's passage from the Gospel might suggest that we spend a few minutes each day in reading Scripture, or are we trying to live on bread alone?*
