### **SHARE LENT-2013**

The Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers Since on the seventh day God was finished with the work he had been doing, he rested on the seventh day from all the work he had undertaken. (Genesis 2:2) Work is more than a way to make a living; it is a form of continuing participation in God's creation. If the dignity of work is to be protected, then the basic rights of workers must be respected—the right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to organize and join unions, to private property, and to economic initiative. (Sharing Catholic Social Teaching)

- 1. What is the importance of having a weekly Sabbath?
- 2. How can we help ensure that workers obtain a living wage?
- 3. What is the difference between free trade and fair trade? As a consumer, what can you do to discourage sweatshops, child labour, and the exploitation of women in the global market?

Session Four ~ Children of Light. Our focus for this session is by baptism we are "children of light", what does it mean to live as "children of light"? In the reading from Paul for this session, "Once you were darkness, Now in the Lord you are light." Live as children of the light... We are called to be more aware of God's plan for all humanity, from the beginning of time to its end, a plan that reaches its fulfillment in Christ. We are invited to take part in our parish's Lenten penitential celebration, look at ourselves as we can live more consciously in Christ and to seek reconciliation with someone from whom we are distant from.
