THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

The Immaculate Conception Prayer Program began August 7 at the 131st Supreme Convention in San Antonio, Texas. The program features an image of Mary as the Immaculate Conception, which is a copy of the original painting in the Cathedral Basilica in Quebec. The church and the Archdiocese of Quebec are celebrating their 350th anniversary in 2014. This is the 16th Marian Prayer Program sponsored by the KofC, beginning with the first program-honoring Mary under her title of Our lady of Guadalupe. In preparation for the 1982 Centennial of the Order the second prayer program was initiated highlighting the Immaculate Conception. The Blessed Mother has been honored by Knights under the titles of Our lady of Perpetual Help, Our Lady of Czestochowa, Our Lady of Pochaiv, Our Lady of the Assumption, Our Lady of the Rosary and Our Lady of Charity. These programs of Marian prayer have gathered more than 16 million people at 140,000 prayer services worldwide. We will be honoring the Immaculate Conception Prayer Program Tuesday, March 4th after the 7pm Mass at St. Anthony's.

GOSPEL REFLECTION Matthew 6:24-34

In today's Gospel from Matthew, Jesus exhorts His disciples "do not worry". They must have shown worry for Jesus to address this. Did they worry about their food, or clothes, or all of these? Jesus, who knew humanity better than anyone ever has, must have realized that simply telling not to worry does not end the worrying. So, Jesus goes on to give a perspective to ally their worries, a sense of priorities. Then He goes on to ask what good their worrying does. Then He reminds them that God takes care of even the birds and the grass, and surely God will take care of the people created in His own image. Don't worry; keep your priorities straight; remember worrying doesn't do any good; trust God. It might not be easy to hand over our worries to God, but it is worth working on! Discussion Questions: Jesus says, "Seek first the Kingdom of God." Look at creation and add to Jesus' examples of how God cares for every creature and all of creation. What would you say to a friend who worries excessively?
