This Sunday's liturgy invites us to be on the move. The Lord commands Abram to "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you". The Gospel relates the journey of Jesus, Peter, James and John up a high mountain. In each case the journey is demanding yet the outcome is rich with blessing. On Wednesday, April 6, we will have the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation). Over this week let us make the journey into the heart of our relationship with God. Take a long loving look at the ways God calls us to grow. Take this challenge and hold it in readiness for the rich blessing that is manifest in the Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation).

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 17:1-9

Three of Jesus' closest friends arrive at a new understanding of Him in today's Gospel. They are allowed to get a glimpse of Him as He will be after His passion, death, and resurrection. Jesus is seen as the fulfillment of the Law (represented by Moses) and the Prophets (represented by Elijah) or the Old Testament. He is Son of God and Messiah, in whom we experience God's presence and in whose image we will be transfigured.

We read today's story of the transfiguration so that we, too, might be led to a new understanding of Jesus. He is greater than we could ever have thought, and tells us, "Do not be afraid. Keep your eyes on me."

Discussion Questions:: How are you like Peter in this Gospel? Seeing Jesus transfigured was so wonderful, He wanted to stay there always. How can you keep your eyes on Jesus in works of justice and mercy, in help for those less fortunate?
