SHARE LENT-2013

Solidarity ~ If one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; if one member is honored, all the members share its joy. You then, are the body of Christ. Every one of you is a member of it.

Learning to practice the virtue of solidarity means that “loving our neighbor” has global dimensions in an inter-dependent world. (Sharing Catholic Social Teaching)

3. From a Christian perspective, what should the role of Canada be in the world?

Session Five ~ Unbinding and being Unbound.

Our focus for this session is Freedom and peace as the first fruits of the Resurrection, Jesus invites us to assist Him in unbinding others. In all reconciliation we see God's Spirit at work, and lastly, giving thanks! We are invited to, as an individual or group, learn how we can comfort those who are saddened by the death of a loved one, take part in a celebration of the sacrament of Reconciliation, pray for healing of victims of sexual abuse and for their families, and look into ourselves and pray for grace to have an increasingly forgiving heart.

Session Six ~ New Creation. Our focus for this session is “We are made new in Christ”, preparing for Easter as a new beginning and living as an Easter people. Our reading from the book of Ezekiel says, “Yes, you were great, you lived in your own land, but you forgot that your greatness was founded on God. You threw away your foundations.” Ezekiel gives to the people a promise from God, “I will bring you home...I will pour clean water over you and cleanse you. Gods' love is so wonderful, no matter what we do He loves us. **We are invited to take action during Holy week and bring new hope for someone. We can invite someone who has dropped out of contact to take part in Holy Week to the celebration of Easter. Invite a family or friend to the next season of Arise this fall or maybe invite someone to join you for Easter dinner.**
