On <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>April 5<sup>th</sup></u>, <u>2017</u> the Sacrament of Penance, Reconciliation, Confession, will be celebrated in our cluster parishes. The response to this endeavor, which started a number of years ago, has continued to grow in the numbers attending every year.
