ANNUAL ALL DAY CONFESSIONS

On **Wednesday, April 5th, 2017** the Sacrament of Penance, Reconciliation, Confession, will be celebrated in our cluster parishes. The response to this endeavor, which started a number of years ago, has continued to grow in the numbers attending every year. There is no better way to prepare oneself spiritually than to come before the Lord and seek His mercy and forgiveness.

If you have not celebrated the Sacrament in a long time, perhaps this is the opportunity to avail yourself to doing so. Father O'Brien and I will be available to hear your confession at St. Anthony's or St. John's on that day between the hours of:

9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon AND 1:30 p.m. to 4:30p.m.

Please know that every parish in the diocese is making the Sacrament available that day. Although, due to particular circumstances (i.e. available priests and unforeseen circumstances,) times may be set based on the availability of priests and the number of parishes he is servicing. It is best to check the times with the parish for confirmation.

Sacramental Helps such as Examination of Conscience and how to the formula to celebrate will be found in your bulletin next weekend.

Let us pray for one another as we come to celebrate and for the priests hearing confessions that day. May the Lord remove any fear we may have and replace it with His mercy and forgiveness.
