**ALL DAY CONFESSIONS**

**WEDNESDAY, MARCH 6, 2013**

This Sunday, our Elect (those seeking to be initiated at the Easter Vigil) will stand before us asking for God’s mercy and help as they proceed through their Lenten journey. As the Elect move through Lent, especially in the scrutinies, they show us how conversion (turning away from sin and being faithful to the Gospel) renews our lives. In preparation for the first scrutiny today, they have prayed for the grace they need to abandon all that keeps them from a full relationship with Christ.

In three days, on **Wednesday, March 6**, all Catholics throughout the Diocese of London will have the opportunity to share in God’s healing and forgiveness. We, too, like the Elect, need to ask for the grace to abandon all that keeps us from living a full relationship with Christ. We need to allow the Lord to wash away our sins in his forgiving love and to make us whole once again.
