

- 3. Are there any businesses you patronize, or avoid, because of social justice principles?



ALL DAY CONFESSIONS WEDNESDAY, MARCH 6, 2013

This Sunday, our Elect (those seeking to be initiated at the Easter Vigil) will stand before us asking for God's mercy and help as they proceed through their Lenten journey. As the Elect move through Lent, especially in the scrutinies, they show us how conversion (turning away from sin and being faithful to the Gospel) renews our lives. In preparation for the first scrutiny today, they have prayed for the grace they need to abandon all that keeps them from a full relationship with Christ.
