**Wednesday, March 21, 2012**

This Sunday's liturgy cries out that God enlightens us, that we stay awake in order to see the brilliance and glory of God's revelation, and in the silence that we ponder what has been revealed. We will be standing outside **LEAMINGTON HOSPITAL** every Thursday evening from **7:00pm until 8:00pm (1 hr.)**

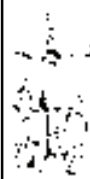
**We will be holding candles and praying.**

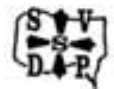
