

MILK BAGS FOR HAITI

On Jan 10, 2010, a devastating earthquake hit Haiti, leveling almost every building and killing many Haitians, leaving many orphans to fend for themselves. I contacted Helen Lewis about getting involved and she got us started with everything we needed to work for these abandoned children. We meet every Tuesday 10am-12noon at St. Andrew's Anglican Church, 210 King St, Harrow with over 30 volunteers working on flattening milk bags, stapling them, cutting them into strips and looping them into balls. Since 2011, we've sent 457 sleeping mats, 66 pillows, 118 small sitting mats and 118 school bags. We either crochet or weave on 6 looms.
