

### **6TH SUNDAY OF EASTER**

#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION** John 15:9-17

Anyone who happened to be in a selfish mood when they heard this Gospel could not get away from it. Love is everywhere in Jesus' conversation with His friends at the Last Supper. He gives them His memorable commandment: "Love one another as I love you". It sounds simple. But He reminds us that loving as He does involves a willingness to "lay down one's life for one's friends." During Lent we saw this love of Jesus in action. Now during the Easter season we rejoice that such love is victorious over sin and death.

Discussion Questions: In what small ordinary ways do you see members of your family, school or parish "laying down their lives" for others? Consider how they place the needs and desires of others before what they want. How do they sacrifice their time, talents, and material goods to help others?
