GOSPEL REFLECTION

John 14:1-12

Jesus and His disciples are gathered for the Last Supper. He tells them He is going to "prepare a place" for them but Thomas points out that they do not know the place or the way to get there. What Thomas and the others have not yet grasped is that Jesus Himself is the way. When Philip asks Jesus to "show us the Father," Jesus makes it clear that He and God the Father are one. The words and works of Jesus are the words and works of the Father.

Discussion Question: The slogan "WWJD" (what would Jesus do?) has become popular among some Christians. Would it help you decide the way of Jesus for you?
