

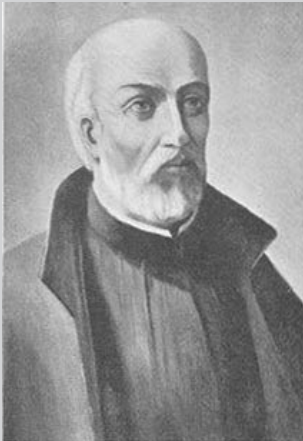

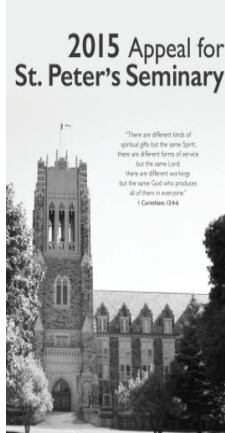

A Message from Father Rick

Well, the month of May has arrived and with it the expectation of getting our hands dirty in the soil of our gardens. It has been a long, cold and snowy winter but it has now passed, (we hope) and we look forward to the warmth of the summer months.

This month always brings special memories to mind for me. As you probably know from the past bulletins, May 12th I will celebrate my 65th birthday. Many say “it’s only a number!” but I usually add, “true, but it’s one that gets bigger every year!” Up to the time of writing this, all has been well with me. My parents are still living, albeit, now residing in long-term care and facing the health issues that 87 & 88 year olds are likely to face. I also have three siblings. Nieces and nephews are getting married and having children; all my aunts and uncles have gone on to their eternal reward and many of my cousins are also decreasing in number as well. It’s the circle of life: new life- death- new life! It has been a good 65 years. Back in 2008, I followed in the footsteps of my Dad and brother when I had cardiac by-pass surgery. Thankfully, all has been well thus far. I now contend with many of the same ailments many face at this age (and earlier) the aches and pains of arthritis in the joints, the pulling of the odd tooth (only one so far in 2014). You know, all the things we face as we age.

On May 10th, I along with 4 of my classmates will celebrate our 40th anniversary of Priestly Ordination. On that day back in 1975 there were 8 of us ordained by Bishop G Emmett Carter, who was later named a Cardinal by St. John Paul 11. It brings a smile to our faces and sometimes a tear to our eyes when we look at our ordination picture. We were soooo young, thin, had hair (mind you, some are now bald and those with hair- a different colour- not by choice.) Three have gone to their eternal reward and a few of them have since retired.

It’s been a blessed and wonderful 40 years and there is nothing else I would rather be doing. My appointments, the priests whom I have served with, the Bishops and the staffs that I have worked with and the many people I have served, both in the parish and the hospital setting, have truly been a blessing to me.

Next Sunday, May 10th, Mother’s Day and the actual anniversary of my ordination, I will offer my Mass in Thanksgiving for my call to serve as priest, for the faith instilled in my life through the example and witness of my Mom and Dad, and the many priests and parishioners who have been an example to me throughout my life.

I ask you to remember me and my classmates, living (and deceased,) that we may continue to serve the Lord in love and joy.

Later this month, St. Peter’s Seminary will hold our alumni reunion – held every three years. We look forward to getting together as the class of ’75. All of us ordained that day for the diocese of London will be present- a first in many years! One classmate will be joining us after being away from the diocese since 1985!

Finally, please know that your prayers for me and all priests are truly appreciated. Our numbers are decreasing, (and ageing) and as we look to the future there will be less of us pastoring more parishes than we are now. The annual seminary collection will be taken within the upcoming weeks of May and, it is a time to remember the need to support the seminary not only with your prayers but financially as well. For many years now the seminary has been preparing men and women to be “servant leaders”, ordained and lay, for not only our diocese but throughout Canada. As always, your generosity is greatly needed and appreciated. Please continue to pray for vocations.

God bless and I look forward to celebrating my two milestones with you the weekend of May 17th.
