WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

Every Catholic has a vocation. In fact, as a member of the Church, every Catholic participates in the reality of "vocation" in three distinct but related senses. First, there is the common Christian vocation that comes in Baptism. We are called to be holy—to become saints! Vocation also refers to a "state in life" or a way of being Christianpriesthood, consecrated live, marriage, and dedicated single life. When people speak of "vocation", they usually mean vocation in the second sense—state in life. Most Christians are called by God to the married state, and some are called to the state of single laypersons living in the world. But Jesus also chooses certain men to act in his Person through the celebration of the Eucharist and other sacraments: they are called to be priests. Others are called to a ministry of service as permanent deacons. And still others, both women and men are called to consecrated life-a way of life marked by the evangelical counsels of poverty, chastity, and obedience—whose most familiar expression is religious life. "A vocation is a fruit that ripens in a well cultivated field of mutual love that becomes mutual service, in the context of an authentic ecclesial life. A vocation flows from the heart of God and blossoms in the good soil of faithful people, in the experience of fraternal love. Did not Jesus say: "By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another" (Jn 13:35)?

Let us dispose our hearts to being "good soil", by listening, receiving and living out the word, and thus bearing fruit. The more we unite ourselves to Jesus through prayer, Scripture, the Eucharist, the sacraments celebrated and lived in the Church, the more there will grow in us the joy of cooperating with God in the service of the Kingdom of mercy and truth, justice and peace. And the harvest will be plentiful, proportionate to the grace we have meekly welcomed into our lives."

On Monday, May 1^{st,} I went to Metropolitan Hospital in Windsor to make my visits to the sick. I was informed that as of that very day the list of patients, which is printed for each of the religious denominations, <u>was not and would no longer be available.</u> Reason? Privacy of Information. This is becoming the norm at all public institutions.

So, as a results of this policy, I will no longer be making visits to the Windsor Hospitals to check the patient lists. <u>IF</u> you are a patient, or going to be and desire a pastoral visit, you, or a member of your family will have to be in contact with the parish office to notify us. You are reminded that there is a chaplain assigned to our hospitals and are available for emergency calls. Please be sure that it is made known that you are Roman Catholic upon admission and wish Holy Communion or a visit from a member of the hospital Pastoral Care team.

And another bit of information regarding Privacy of Information:

If any of our parishioners are presently, or will be, residents in one of our Retirement Homes or Long Term Care facilities, the same policy applies. Please inform us of the name of the residence and the room they are living in. This makes it much easier for our Eucharistic Ministers when they bring the Eucharist on the Sundays they are scheduled to go. It also helps us to be informed when they are transferred to another residence.

As you can see, the times are a changing and whether we like it or not, we have to as well! If you have any questions, don't hesitate to contact me.

A Note about our Parish Prayer List for the Sick

We are happy and encourage you to request prayers for the sick of our parish community and your loved ones. We have Prayer Warriors to whom we send the names of the sick to be prayed for, however, we must have permission from the person him/herself or authorized by a family member personally. Once again, the policy of Privacy of Information is in effect. You have to know that there are some individuals who do not want it to be known that they are ill and although want to be remembered in prayer but NOT publically. This is to be respected. If that person would like to receive Holy Communion at home, they also must make the request. Once again, they are to call the office to request and inform us.
