The theme for the 2016 World Communications Day is

Communication and Mercy: A Fruitful Encounter.

World Communications Day was established by Paul VI after the Second Vatican Council in order to draw attention to the "the vast and complex phenomenon of the modern means of social communication."

Once again, Pope Francis is reminding us that, in its essence, communication is a profoundly human achievement. Good communication is never merely the product of the latest or most developed technology, but is realized within the context of a deep interpersonal relationship. World Communications Day, the only worldwide celebration called for by the Second Vatican Council ("Inter Mirifica", 1963), is marked in most countries, on the recommendation of the bishops of the world, on the **Sunday before Pentecost.**
