BUILDING RENOVATIONS

St. John's received the green light to proceed with MUCH NEEDED repairs to our rectory flat roofs. Out of three tenders received and approved by the Diocese, Gillett Roofing Inc. of Leamington was awarded the contract for \$86,983.00 and the work began this past Tuesday, Nov. 9. We will keep you posted as we get the approval from the diocese to proceed with the other pending projects.

Pending projects at St. John's (not in any particular order) church roof repairs (leak near choir loft), bell tower (3 cracks), painting, cleaning, lighting, parking lot repaving/repairs, parish kitchen & hall etc. At St. Anthony's, we are in the process of receiving estimates to replace the entrance doors. If you wish to donate to these capital projects make donations to your church and on the envelope mark *Building Fund*. Thank you for your patience & support.
