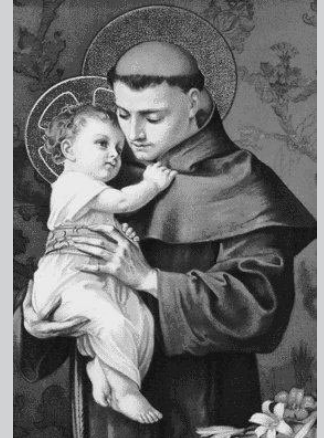

BILL C-51

Please read Clause 14 of the new Bill.
