Settlement support to a refugee family includes:

- Orienting them to life in Canada (taking them to the grocery store, appointments, etc.)
- Arranging temporary accommodation/helping them find permanent accommodation
- Applying for Interim Federal Health Program
- Applying for Health Card
- Enrolling children in school
- Enrolling family members in English classes
- Assisting the family in finding doctor, dentist and other health services
- Applying for Social Insurance Number
- Assisting in job search
- Opening a bank account
- Providing emotional and moral support
