



GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 25:31-46

Today on the Feast of Christ the King, we read that a ruler or leader should be like a shepherd. The leader is to care for all the people and protect them. And a wise and loving ruler knows that what is important for the people is equally important for their leader. In today's Gospel, the ruler is also a judge. At the last judgment, Christ is pictured as the king who judges the nations. How does He judge? On the basis of care and concern for the needy.
