

GOSPEL REFLECTION Matthew 24:37-44

In today's Gospel, we are asked to live in the present with an eye toward the future. We are not to be totally absorbed by the usual activities of life. We are to remain open to the coming of the Lord, and be prepared. Here Jesus compares Himself to a thief who breaks in when no one is looking!
