

31ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

GOSPEL REFLECTION Mark 12: 28-34

In this reading, Jesus is asked to name "the first of all the commandments." In the first part of His reply, Jesus quotes the words from today's Gospel: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength." Then Jesus adds another commandment from Leviticus 19:18: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Jesus made the two commandments one. We now call this the Great Commandment. Loving God and loving neighbor cannot be separated. We love God by loving our neighbor as we love ourselves. The proof and measure of how we love God is shown in how much we love others.

Discussion Questions: Name some ways or times that loving others is a joyful experience. Name some ways or times that loving others can cost us time, effort, and inconvenience.
