

GOSPEL REFLECTION Matthew 25:1-13

Why do we need the gift of wisdom? Why do we need to be prepared daily for Christ's coming? The parable in today's Gospel provides some answers. According to the parable, five foolish bridesmaids go out to meet the bridegroom without bringing extra oil for their lamps (the bridegroom in this story represents Christ). When the bridegroom's family arrives at midnight, the foolish bridesmaids have to run off in the opposite direction to purchase more oil. By the time they get back, the door to the wedding celebration is locked and the groom says to them "I do not know you."

Discussion Questions: How does Jesus come at life's end? How can we wisely be ready when He comes? Why would an oil lamp burning be a symbol of wisdom and remind you of this Gospel?
