1ST READING REFLECTION

2 Maccabees 7: 1-2, 9-14

This reading may seem like a strange horror story, but it's an actual account of seven Jewish brothers and their mother who were tortured and killed for their faith. They were martyred during the reign of Antiochus 111, a Syrian king who forced the people of God to adopt pagan religious practices. The heroes of today's reading refused to break any of the dietary laws of Moses. The best part of the story for us is the Jewish family's faith in their own resurrection. Although they lived two centuries before Christ, their faith helped to prepare the way for His coming.

Discussion Questions: Sometimes it is only in difficult situations that we really know what we believe. What has been difficult for you lately? How have you responded to the difficulty?

Once again, we are making available **Daily Reflections for Advent & Christmas--Waiting in Joyful Hope** by Bishop Robert Morneau.
