**DEVELOPMENT & PEACE
THE INJUSTICE OF HUNGER
"SOW MUCH LOVE"**

Last December, Pope Francis launched a call to the Church worldwide, including each of us, to be part of a global campaign to fight hunger in the world today.

One Human Family, Food for All, is a battle cry against the suffering and scandal of global hunger. Development and Peace joined this international campaign for our 2014 Lent campaign and has chosen to continue to take action on this issue of global hunger. Under the slogan "*Sow Much Love*", we are inviting you to join our Fall action campaign and support the right of farmers to use, conserve, exchange and save their seeds, which feed the world. Seeds are part of God's magnificent creation. Farmers are the natural stewards of these seeds which provide food for all.

This Fall, Development and Peace Members across Canada will join Caritas Internationalis and Catholics around the world who are working to address global hunger. *We will be invited to take action on this global issue at all Masses on November 22/23.*

MINISTRY NEWS (A few changes)


From time to time, at our Sunday Masses, individuals will come forward at the distribution of Holy Communion and present a PYX to receive a consecrated host from one of the Eucharistic ministers. (The PYX is a small receptacle to carry the Blessed Sacrament.) At a recent meeting of the Eucharistic Ministers it was decided that this procedure will no longer take place. Those who wish to bring the Eucharist from Mass must, of course, be a mandated Minister of the Eucharist by Bishop Fabbro, and now place the PYX on the altar before Mass and collect it following the Mass. Our Eucharistic Ministers at both parishes have been instructed not to place a consecrated host in the PYX at that time, but direct you to place the PYX on the altar to be retrieved before leaving the church at the end of Mass. The Diocese of London does not permit what is known as INTINCTION, the dipping of the Body of Christ into the Precious Blood before consuming it. *Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.*
