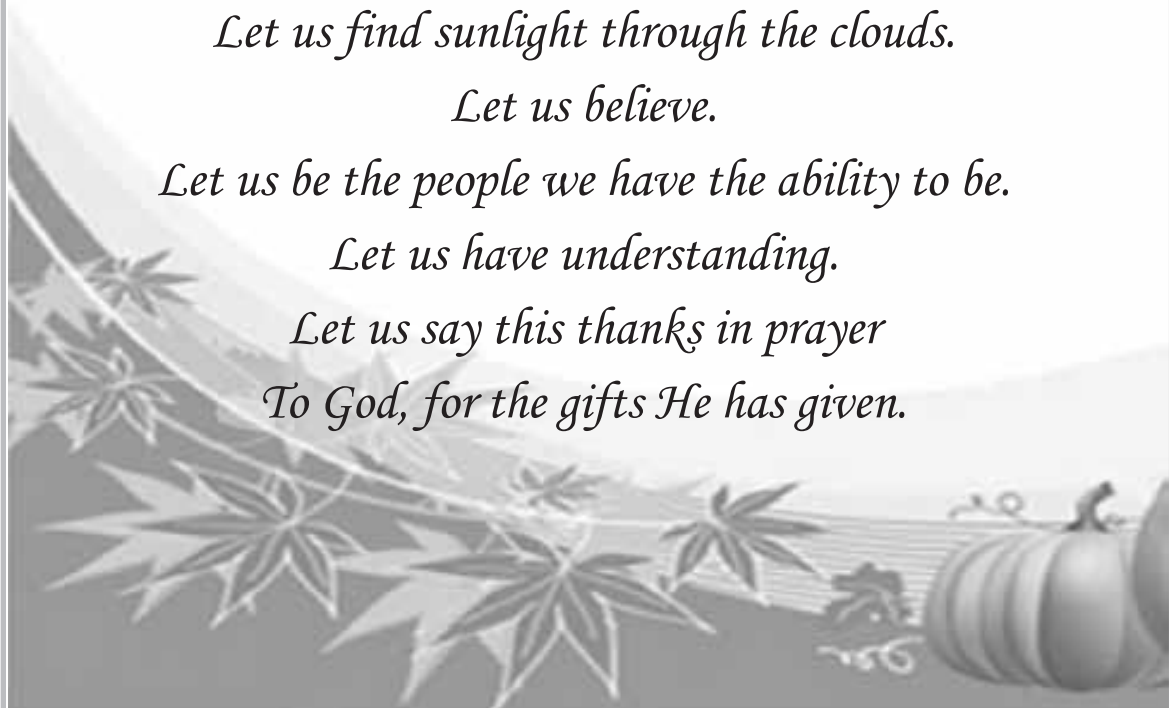

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Luke 17:11-19

In this story of a miraculous healing, ten lepers cry out to Jesus for help. In Jesus' time, lepers were outcasts of society. Jesus tells them to go show themselves to the priests, who will witness their healed condition and allow them back into society. Only one leper, a Samaritan, returns to Jesus to praise and thank God. The man is not a Jew but a foreigner. Jesus points out that the Samaritan leper has gained something far more important than a physical cure; he has gained his eternal salvation.

Discussion Questions: Did you ever wonder why the other nine lepers did not return to thank Jesus? Do you always thank someone for a gift? Why or why not? How do you do it. When and how do you give thanks to God for His gifts to you?

Have you ever considered the priesthood? Spend a weekend in prayer, discussions with priests, faculty and seminarians at St. Peter's Seminary in London. This weekend is open to all single Catholic men 17 years and older. Take some time and hear the voice of God in your life.
