

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Mark 10:17-27

The rich young man in the Gospel is like a mountain climber who has almost reached the summit. But the final stretch will be more difficult than the distance he has already come. He comes to seek wisdom from Jesus about how to achieve everlasting life. He assures the Good Teacher that he has kept the commandments since he was a child. Jesus looks at him with love and challenges him to do one more thing. If he wants to reach the summit of treasure in heaven, the young man must sell his possessions and follow Jesus. This he cannot do, so he goes away sad. Jesus assures His disciples that entering the kingdom of God is no easy matter. Those who are attached to their possessions will have a more difficult time. However, those who rely on God to achieve the impossible can do all good things.

Discussion Questions: What message is Jesus giving us about our attitudes toward riches? Do you think the Gospel story has a happy ending? Why?

THE YEAR OF FAITH-Oct. 11, 2012-Nov. 24, 2013 In his Apostolic Letter, Porta Fidei Pope Benedict XV1 announced a Year of Faith which will begin October 11, 2012, the fiftieth anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council. and which will end on November 24, 2013, the Solemnity of Christ the King. Pope Benedict hopes that the Year of Faith will "help Catholics appreciate the gift of faith, deepen their relationship with God and strengthen their commitment to sharing faith with others." This Year of Faith is meant to turn us once again to the Lord Jesus, to rediscover our faith and to encourage us to be faith-filled witnesses who inspire others. It is a special opportunity for us to look again at the Catechism of the Catholic Church and the documents of the Second Vatican Council. I have ordered a special booklet entitled. "A Minute in the Church" by Gus Lloyd that will be mailed at the end of October. There are a number of "minute" reflections to help us better know and understand what we as Roman Catholics believe. Each will have references to the Catholic Catechism and Sacred Scripture. More information to follow.


THE NEW EVANGELIZATION
