Nest weekend, October 8-9th, Anthony Rebkowec, a parishioner at St. John de Brebeuf in Kingsville, will celebrate the MINISTRY of ACOLYTE. Bishop Fabbro has delegated me to celebrate the institution of this ministry. I ask you to read the information below about this ministry and pray for Anthony and his family as he receives it and completes his final year before being ordained to the order of Deacon.

# The Diaconate Candidate and the Instituted Ministry of Acolyte

The Acolyte serves at the altar and assists the priest and deacon. It is his place principally to prepare the altar and the sacred vessels, and, if necessary, to distribute the Eucharist to the faithful and an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion at Mass and to bring the Eucharist to the sick or homebound. The Acolyte may also be involved in preparing the books, vestments and sacred vessels necessary for Mass and other liturgies. This October, nine men, who are preparing for ordination as Permanent deacons for the Diocese of London in November 2017, will be instituted into the ministry of Acolyte, by their pastors, in the presence of their parish communities. Please pray for: Art Bondy, Leo Gulikers, Brian Hanley, Tony Hogervorst, Tom MacLeod, Anthony Rebkowec, Victor Salazar and Don St. Onge. Before he is eligible to be ordained, a man in formation for the diaconate must have received the ministries of Lector and Acolyte and must have exercised these ministries for an appropriate time. The men being instituted into the ministry of Acolyte this October received the ministry of Lector last November, at St. Peter's Seminary. You may have noticed them serving more visibly as Lectors at Mass and other liturgical services during the past year. Exercising this ministry of Acolyte gives the diaconate candidate a unique opportunity to come to a deeper understanding of his call to ministry of Sacrament and how this relates to his distinctive vocation to serve those who are in any kind of need. Because of this experience, he will better be able to approach his ordination "fervent in spirit, serving the Lord, constant in prayer and aware of the needs of the faithful" (Romans 12.11-13)

It must be emphasized that the diaconate candidates' exercise of his ministry of Acolyte during the year before his ordination is not intended to impact upon the adults and young people who are, currently, involved in ministries of liturgical service as extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, altar servers and sacristans, carrying out their roles with commitment and reverence. Appropriately trained members of the laity will always be needed to fulfill these most essential liturgical functions.
