

### GOSPEL REFLECTION

Luke 17:5-10

The two sayings of Jesus in today's Gospel make us wonder about the other side of the story. When the apostles ask, "Increase our faith", are they secretly quite satisfied with their record of faithfulness? Jesus tells them that if they really have faith they can tell a tree what to do, and it will do it! The story about the servant tells us that Jesus' disciples should be grateful to God. When we do God's will, we should not expect to receive a gold medal. We have, after all, done no more than "what we were obliged to do."

Discussion Questions: What is your attitude toward the next good thing asked of you? Do you say, "I'll get it, I'll do it!" All Jesus asks is that we love one another, not that we just stand around talking about loving one another!
