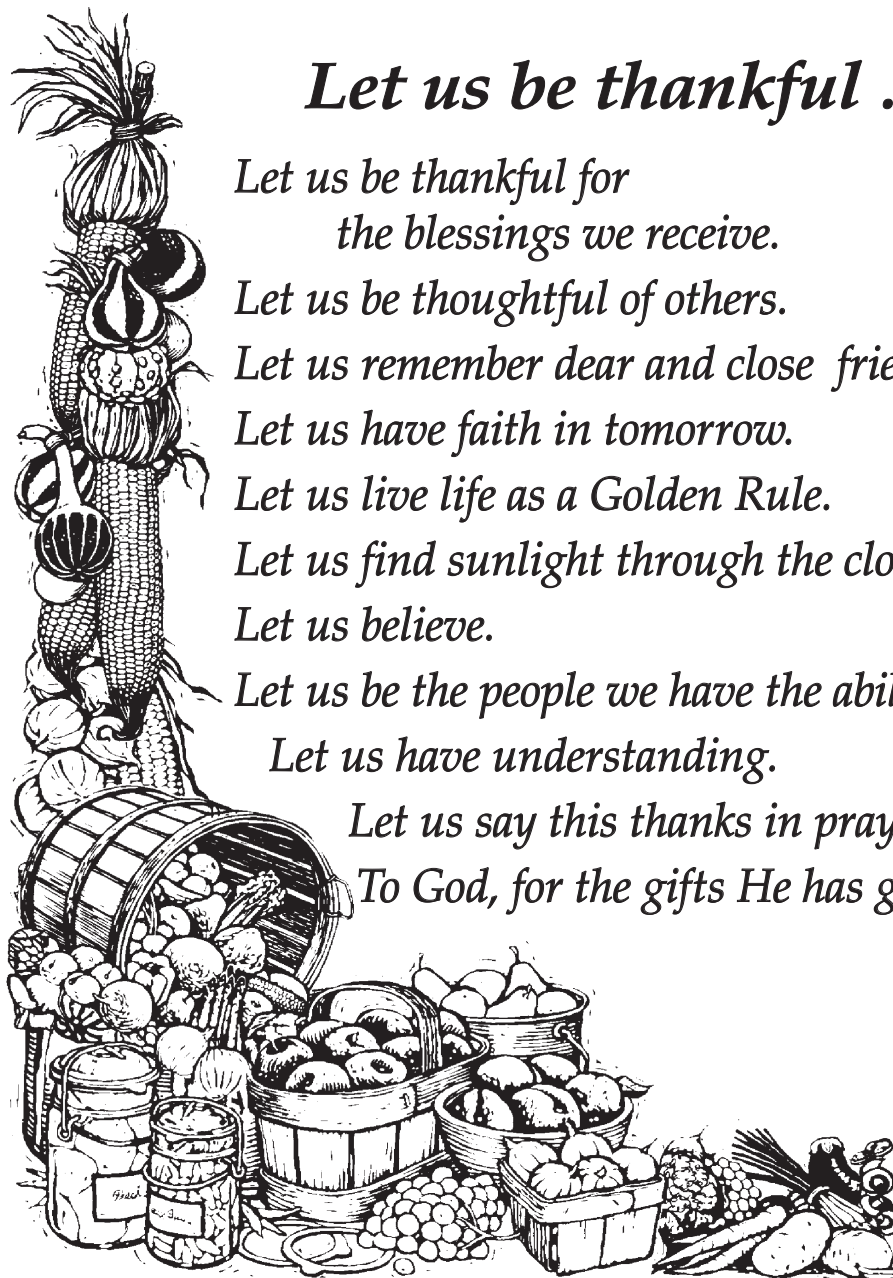

Further discussion regarding these issues and the overall condition of St. Anthony will be the focus of an upcoming meeting.

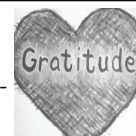
At this time, ONLY those persons authorized by the pastor will be allowed to enter the hall.
