ST. ANTHONY HALL DEMOLITION

As indicated earlier, the church hall which has been closed for close to a year by direction of the Diocese, is nearing demolition.

At the time of writing , the diocese is finalizing the steps in preparation for its demolition. Our target date **is September 18**th/**2017** and although we do not have a total figure of the cost, it will be in the neighbourhood of \$50,000 plus. Electrical, plumbing and other disconnections will be extra as will be engineers fees.

Although not at this time, it is planned to fill the open area with a much needed parking lot, albeit small.

We were blessed with a very successful fundraiser for the house, church and chapel roof shingling last fall and hopefully we will be as successful in raising the needed funds for the demolition.

While there is very little to salvage from the building there are a number of church pews that parishioners might be interested in purchasing. Available would be: 3 pews (7 $\frac{1}{2}$ long); 2 pews (18 $\frac{1}{2}$ long): 1 pews (13 $\frac{1}{2}$ long): 1 pew (6 feet long). These pews could be used as deacon benches to place in a hallway or in the basement. The purchaser would be responsible for pick-up and this would have to be done on one set day, as entrance into the hall is closed due to health regulations. This date will be decided upon depending on the number of sales. The cost for the pews as is: short pews: \$175 and long \$250. All monies collected for the sale will go towards the cost of the demolition.

I would ask that all parishioners prayerfully consider making a donation to cover the cost of the demolition. Please make your cheque payable to St. Anthony's parish, and write **"Demolition"** on the outside of the envelope. This is the only way an income tax receipt may be issued either for cheque or cash. Just be sure to include your name and address on the envelope.

GOD'S WATCHERS

In the ancient world watchmen were extremely important people. They kept communities safe, and were there to alert them to any impending danger or attack. Before



locks, alarms, and security systems, watchmen were the protectors, the safety measure. So when the Lord charges Ezekiel as a watchman today, it is a weighty charge.
