

#### SYRIAN REFUGEE FAMILY INFORMATION

I wanted to give everyone a quick update about a meeting that my wife Jennifer, Colleen Marcuzzi and I had last night with a friend and family members of our sponsored families. We met a friend of our first sponsored family who himself came over as a refugee about a year and a half ago and lives and works in Windsor. He is currently aiding the family financially to help them pay for medication and food since they are not able to work while they wait to come to Canada from Lebanon where the four of them are staying in a single room.

We also met with a couple who are the brother and sister of our second sponsored family (we are sponsoring his sister and her brother along with their 2 children). They have lived in Canada for over a decade. In the past year or so they have raised money and sponsored his brother and family (4 children) to come to Canada but were not able to raise enough to also bring over his sister's family which is our second sponsored family. Because they are a minority they are not able to travel freely and cannot work. The man we met has been working many overtime hours to be able to send money to his sister's family to help them survive as they wait for their interview with the United Nations Refugee organization. All three of the individuals that we met with were extremely thankful and appreciative of our entire group and our efforts to allow their friends and family members to come to the safety of Canada and to be reunited with them. It was very difficult for all of them at times describing the living conditions and horribly traumatic things that the families have had to endure.

The meeting really reinforced how lucky we are to live in a peaceful country like Canada and how small our problems are relative to what so many living in violence and war must deal with. We were very touched at how genuine and grateful they were. It was truly a positive experience and we know that our two sponsored families are looking forward to the time when they will be able to travel to Canada.

Feel free to talk to myself, Jen or Colleen to hear more about the meeting. Unfortunately we still don't know exactly when any of them will be arriving, but the home for the first family is furnished and waiting for them.

Please pray that both families will be safe while they wait to come to Canada. Thank you for your support and prayers,
