# 24THSUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION** Mark 8:27-35

In today's Gospel, Jesus teaches His disciples what they have gradually come to discover: He is indeed the Messiah. But He is a Messiah who must suffer and die. Peter found this hard to accept. For Peter, the Messiah would not, could not, suffer. Judging by human standards, not God's, Peter failed to accept God's will for the Messiah. Jesus assured all His disciples that they too, must suffer: deny themselves, take up the cross, and follow Him.

Discussion Questions: Have you ever been rejected for doing what was right or for "not" going along with the crowd? What "crosses" do you have to "take up" in your life right now? Will you ask Jesus to help you?

The best mathematical equation I have ever seen: 1 cross + 3 nails = 4 given.
