GOSPEL REFLECTION

Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

The word “hypocrite” comes from an ancient Greek term meaning “actor”. In the Gospel, Jesus accuses the religious leaders of being hypocrites. They act as though they are speaking for God but they are really speaking about what matters to them. Jesus points out that they are more concerned about pious practices than they are about God’s commandments. They criticized Jesus’ disciples for not washing their hands before eating. But they showed no interest in the goodness of the disciples’ hearts. Jesus teaches that religious rules and regulations should never become more important than God’s people. He wants us to understand that our outward behavior should reflect what is in our hearts. A good heart will not produce evil actions. Nor will washing our hands make us clean inside where it really counts.

Discussion Questions: How would you explain why having a good heart is more important than giving God “lip service”?
