SACRAMENTS

Most Catholics know that there are seven Sacraments: Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders and Matrimony. But what really is a Sacrament and what do they do? In the Catechism of the Catholic Church, P. 1131, it says this: "The Sacraments are efficacious signs of grace, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church by which divine life is dispensed to us." What does that all mean? Think of it like this. Many other Christian churches baptize or receive Communion. But they view those things as purely symbolic. We believe that God actually DOES something in the Sacraments. He gives grace, forgives sins, imbues us with the Holy Spirit and, in many cases, puts an indelible mark, or character, on our souls. Rather than just being symbol, God actually works in and through the Sacraments. When we are open to God's work in the Sacraments, the Catechism tells us that "they bear fruit in those who receive them with the required dispositions." Let's pray that, as we participate in the Sacramental life of the Church, we will bear much fruit. For further study: CCC 113-1134


