**GOSPEL REFLECTION**

Matthew 20: 1-16a

Our ideas of justice are some times selfish and petty when we compare them to God's justice. That is why some people are surprised that Jesus would tell a story in which five groups of workers who began at different times should all be paid the same at sun-down. Yet Jesus points out that those who worked all day received a fair wage and a wage they agreed on from the start. The landowner, who represents God in the story, asks "Are you envious because I am generous?" The answer for many people is yes. They have forgotten that God's ways are not our ways. They do not remember that the blessings of God's kingdom are a gift to us.

*Discussion Questions: Have you ever thought, "That's not fair?" How did thinking like that make you feel? We have been told that God's ways are not our ways. What does that mean in this parable?*

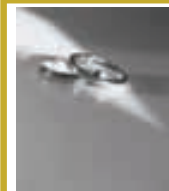

## SACRAMENTS

Most Catholics know that there are seven Sacraments: Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders and Matrimony. But what really is a Sacrament and what do they do? In the Catechism of the Catholic Church, P. 1131, it says this: "The Sacraments are efficacious signs of grace, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church by which divine life is dispensed to us." What does that all mean? Think of it like this. Many other Christian churches baptize or receive Communion. But they view those things as purely symbolic. We believe that God actually DOES something in the Sacraments. He gives grace, forgives sins, imbues us with the Holy Spirit and, in many cases, puts an indelible mark, or character, on our souls. Rather than just being symbol, God actually works in and through the Sacraments. When we are open to God's work in the Sacraments, the Catechism tells us that "they bear fruit in those who receive them with the required dispositions." Let's pray that, as we participate in the Sacramental life of the Church, we will bear much fruit. For further study: CCC 113-1134
