CALL UPON THE LORD

The very first line of today's first reading summons us to seek the Lord and to call upon God. This sentiment is echoed in the refrain for today's responsorial psalm: "The Lord is near to all who call upon him" (Psalm 145:18a). Saint Paul is the embodiment of someone who constantly sought the Lord. In the excerpt we read today from his letter to the Philippians, we find Saint Paul toward the end of his life, a life he describes as completely consonant with Christ.

He writes, "For to me life is Christ" (Philippians 1:21). To find out what it means to live life completely in accord with Christ we need look no further than today's Gospel. There we find that God's love and mercy are immeasurable for all those who seek and call upon the Lord.

We have recently received word that the second family which our clustered parish is sponsoring is tentatively scheduled to travel to Canada at the end of this month. This is very exciting news and will finally remove this family from a very dangerous situation and will reunite them with family members here in Canada. The challenging task of finding housing and getting prepared for their arrival now begins. We are looking for a rental property in Kingsville that would be suitable for a family of 4 with 2 children aged 8 and 9. We will also be collecting household items to furnish the family's home: furniture, appliances, towels, bedding and kitchen items to ensure that the family will be comfortable to begin the long road of acclimating to life in a new country.
