GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 21:28-32

Jesus tells a parable to a group of religious leaders. He wants them to figure out which one of the sons did His father's will. Was it the one who said yes but never showed up? Or was it the one who said no but later repented and carried out the father's wishes. Sometimes people can deceive us by smooth talk. But God is never deceived. Like Jesus, our lives can be a "yes" to God the Father in word and deed.

Discussion Questions: *Has you ever said "yes" to someone and then not done what you agreed to do? Did you every say "no" to someone who asked you (like a friend or relative) but then regretted it and changed your mind? Jesus is making it clear that sinners who repent are entering the kingdom before the priests and elders who did not repent and believe. What do you think of this?*
